3. What Data We Collect

We collect only what is necessary to provide you with the best possible experience.

- Data You Provide Directly
- Contact information: Name, email address, phone number.
- Purchase details: Shipping address, order contents.
- Account information (if applicable): Login credentials.
- Messages and feedback: Any communication you send to us.
- Data Collected Automatically
- Website usage data: IP address, browser type, pages visited, referring URLs.
- Cookies and similar technologies: To improve your browsing experience.

4. How We Use Your Data

We only use your personal data when the law allows us to. Here's what we use it for:

- To fulfil orders and deliver products.
- To provide customer support.
- To manage your account (if applicable).
- To send occasional updates, promotions, and news—only if you opt in.
- To improve our website and products through analytics.
- To comply with legal obligations.

We will never sell your data to third parties.



5. Legal Bases for Processing

Under the UK GDPR, we rely on the following lawful grounds:

- Contractual necessity: To process your orders and provide services.
- **Consent:** For sending marketing communications.
- Legitimate interests: To improve our services and manage security.
- Legal obligation: To comply with tax and regulatory requirements.

6. Sharing Your Data

We only share your data when absolutely necessary:

- **Service providers:** Payment processors, shipping partners, website hosting.
- **Legal authorities:** If required by law or to protect our rights.

All third parties are contractually required to keep your information secure and use it only for the intended purpose.

7. Data Retention

We retain your personal data only as long as necessary:

- Order data: 7 years (for accounting/legal reasons).
- Marketing data: Until you withdraw consent.
- Website logs: Typically 12 months.

When no longer needed, your data is securely deleted or anonymized.



8. Your Rights

You have full control over your personal data:

- Right to access: Ask what data we hold about you.
- Right to rectification: Correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- **Right to erasure:** Request deletion of your data.
- **Right to restrict processing:** Limit how we use your data.
- **Right to data portability:** Receive your data in a transferable format.
- **Right to object:** To direct marketing or certain types of processing.
